Application in prescribed standard format are hereby invited from the citizens of India as defined Articles 5 to 8 of constitution of India for filling up temporary posts of Physical Education Teacher (PET) / Laboratory Assistant and Handicraft teacher in the Pay Matrix Level indicated against each for Govt. Secondary Schools/ Higher Secondary Schools of the State. The recruitment of posts as given below will be made as reservation policy of 80:20 ratio enforced by the Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh from time to time.

**II. ELIGIBILITY:**

(i). **Education Qualification**

a. **Physical Education Teacher (PET):** Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed/ B.P.E).

b. **Laboratory Assistant:** Bachelor in Science (B.Sc.) from recognized university.

c. **Handicraft Teacher:** Class 12 passed (for APST Class 10 Passed) from recognized board with Diploma in Craftsmanship.

(ii) **AGE LIMIT**

Physical Education Teacher (PET) : 21-28 years

Laboratory Assistant : 18-28 years

Handicraft Teacher : 18-28 years

However, upper age limit for 5 years is relaxable incase of APST candidates as per Government of Arunachal Pradesh prescribed norms & rules.

**III. RESERVATION:**

Reservation is admissible in respect of meritorious sports person having gold medal in International/ National/ Inter-University level sport event are kept as per Govt. policies. On the other hand in respect of PWD candidates only for those who suffer from not less than 40 % of relevant disability. The eligible meritorious sports person should not appear in written test, they will be called at the time of viva-voce only. In case of non-availability of PWD or meritorious sports person, the post reserved for them shall be filled up by direct recruitment as per the norms.

**IV. MODE OF SELECTION**

Eligible candidates will be called for appearing written examination as below:

The candidates must secure minimum of 33% or above in Sl. No (i), (ii) & (iii) in the written examination. The normal ratio for short listing the candidates for viva-voce test will be 1:3. The selection will be made strictly on merit on the basis of the marks secured in the written & viva-voce test.
