C I R C U L A R.

The Department of Education, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh through the Directorate of Secondary Education is going to conduct the State Merit Scholarship Examination on 5th Nov'2018(Monday) for class- VIII passed students to identify the meritorious students and to give them financial incentive in the form of scholarship for better pursuit of quality education.

1. **Eligibility :-** (a) Students who have dully passed the annual promotion Examination of class- VIII in Academic Session 2017-18 securing in aggregate 60% /(grade B2) and above now reading in class- IX in Govt/Govt. Aided/ Pvt. Schools/ Unaided Pvt Schools of Arunachal Pradesh only are eligible for the examination.

(b) There is no age bar for the Examination.

2. **Application:-**

(a) All application should be filled in prescribed format which can be obtained from the DDSE or Head of institution office and a Xerox copy of the same can be used for the purpose.

(b) The dully filled-up application form of the candidate with due counter signature of the Head of the institution be sent directly to the "Director of Secondary Education, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh Itanagar-791111 in a super inscribed Envelop" **Application for State Merit Scholarship Examiantion'2018.**

(c) No. application fee is charged for the examination.

(d) The last date of submission and receipt of filled-up application is 3rd Sept'2018.

(e) The admit card of the selected candidate are to be collected by the School authority from the DSE Office, Itanagar and distribute to the concerned student in time.

3. **Examination Processes:-**

(a) The Examination will be conducted centrally at Itanagar in Govt. Hr. Sec. School Arunodaya/ Itanagar/Govt. Middle School, Itanagar and the Principal/Head Master of the concerned school will act as centre Supdt.

(b) Question paper:- (i) There will be 1(One) Test Booklet of objective/multiple choice questions comprising of 4(Four) sections- English (Grammar), Maths, Science and Social Science.

(ii) The Test Booklet will be of Maximum = 100 Marks and each section will have the weightage of 25 marks.

(c) **Duration of Examination:-** The examination will be conducted in continuous for 2 ½ hours. (two and Half)

(d) **Medium of examination:-** The medium of Examination will be English.

(e) **Syllabi to be covered:-** The question will be asked based on the whole contents of the NCERT Text Books prescribed for class- VIII standard.

(f) **Answer Script:-** Separate OMR Answer sheet will be provided.

(g) **Admit Card:-** Admittance of Candidate in the Examination will be made on issue of Admit Card.
