**ORDER**


The Director of Secondary Education, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, Itanagar is pleased to inform to all the DDSEs of the District of Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh that the 2<sup>nd</sup> (Under 17) Girls and 8<sup>th</sup> (Under 17) Boys District level Subroto Mukherjee Football Tournament 2019-20 is to be conducted and completed on or before 07<sup>th</sup> July 2019. In this regard, all the DDSEs are also directed to furnish the details of the District champion School who will be participating in the state level Subroto Mukherjee Cup Football Tournament 2019-20. The date of the State Level Tournament is fixed w.e.f. 17<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> July 2019 at Itanagar / Naharlagun. And the arrival of District Girls team at Itanagar is scheduled on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2019 (Afternoon) and the District Boys team on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2019 (Afternoon).

As per the Indian Air Force Sports Control Board (IAFSCB), New Delhi, the International Subroto Mukerjee Cup Football Tournament 2019 is scheduled w.e.f. 20<sup>th</sup> August to 20<sup>th</sup> September 2019 at New Delhi.

The age bracket as per IAFSCB is that, a player must be **born on or after 01<sup>st</sup> January 2003** for the District, State Level and International Tournament. The **Original Registration form of District Level Tournament with the photograph** of the players along with fourth referee report of the tournament particularly the District Champion School is to be sent to this Directorate for further participation in the state level.

The DDSE shall submit a report of the District Level Tournament with the total number of participated schools with name and group photographs of each and every match played in the tournament. If any School is absent, the details may also be furnished.



# **Terms and Conditions for the State & District Level Subroto Mukerjee Cup Football Tournament U-17 Boys & U-17 Girls.**

**(These Terms & Conditions will stand valid till further order)**

## **Fixture:**

1. All the matches shall be played according to the match schedule prepared by the Organizing Committee. The fixture shall be notified at least 10 days prior to the commencement of the tournament. The Organizing Committee shall, however, be empowered to notify any subsequent changes, if necessary by special or unforeseen circumstances.
2. All matches shall be played as per the schedule date and time shown in the schedule unless otherwise notified by the Organizing Committee. A team which fails to turn up for a scheduled game shall be liable to be disqualified from the Tournament. However, the final decision regarding participation of a team rests with the Organizing Committee.

## **Composition of Teams:**

3. A team shall be limited to sixteen players, one Coach and one Manager only. Those players whose names have been intimated to the Organizing Committee on the entry form signed by the Principal/Headmaster of the school shall be eligible to play in the tournament. Entry forms must be duly certified and countersigned by the Principal/Headmaster of the concerned school. Incomplete entry forms will not be accepted and respective teams will not be permitted to play in the tournament.

## **Eligibility of Players:**

4. Only bonafide students of the schools who have been on the rolls of the school concerned from the beginning of the academic year or team shall be eligible to play in the tournament for the school team subject to age criteria given below in Para 5 to 7.
5. **Junior Boys (U-17):** to be eligible to represent his school team, a player in the Junior Boys Group (Under-17 years) should be born on or after 01 January 2003.
6. **Junior Girls (U-17):** to be eligible to represent her school team, a player in the Junior Girls Group (Under-17 years) should be born on or after 01 January 2003.
7. The age as per Birth Certificate (issued during 2013 or before) shall be accepted for this purpose.

## **Medical Examination to Determine Age:**

8. All the participating players would be subjected to a medical examination under the Organizing committee's arrangements for determining the correct age. The findings of the medical examination shall be binding. 'NO' appeal against the decision of the medical board shall be entertained. Players would have to undergo X-ray examination in this regard, if required. Only teams who are willing to undergo medical examination should be sending in their entries.

9. **In case four or more player's particular team are found over aged, the team will not be permitted to participate in the tournament.**

### **Acceptance of Teams:**

10. The final acceptance of teams shall rest with the Organizing Committee. The Organizing Committee may at its discretion, refuse any application for participation in the tournament without assigning any reason.
11. Only teams which agree to abide by all the terms and conditions enumerated in this information should apply for participation in the Subroto Mukerjee Cup Football Tournament. An application subsequent to the perusal of this information automatically implies the term 'acceptance' of the same and no queries / representations regarding these would be entertained at a later date. Any team finds any of these rules and regulations unacceptable may inform the Organizing Committee and withdraw its entry up to 10 days prior to the start of the tournament. No disputes on these issues would be entertained thereafter.

### **Rules of the Games:**

12. The tournament shall be conducted on 'League / Knockout' system and shall be played in accordance with the laws and rules relating to FIFA/ASFCB as accepted and interpreted by the District Football Association.
13. The duration of the game shall be **35 minutes each half for Junior Boys U-17**, with an interval of 10 minutes. In the event of a draw, extra time of 7 minutes each half with a one minute interval shall be played at the discretion of the Organizing Committee. If a match remains undecided after extra time, Kicks from the Penalty Mark would be enforced.
14. The duration of the game shall be **30 minutes each half for Junior Girls U-17**, with an interval of 10 minutes. In the event of a draw, extra time of 7 minutes each half with a one minute interval shall be played at the discretion of the Organizing Committee. If a match remains undecided after extra time, Kicks from the Penalty Mark would be enforced.

16. In case, 'points', 'goal scored', and 'goal conceived' are all equal, the result of league match played between the tied teams would be considered. Even if, this result is also a draw, the committee shall decide the winner on the basis of spin of coin or by draw of lots, in the presence of the Managers/Coaches of the tied teams all the players participating in the tournament shall play wearing shirt, shorts, football shoes, shin guards and stockings of standard pattern as prescribed by the laws of the game published by FIFA.
17. Players must be in possession of identity cards. Blanks cards will be arranged by the Organizing Committee. On arrival at the venue for the tournament, the teams are to handover the duly completed identity cards to the Organizing Committee

for verification and retention. All Identity Cards are to be affixed with a photograph of the player duly attested by the Principal/Headmaster of the School. A rubber stamp of the school is to be prominently displayed on the card along with the date.

18. The Referees for each match shall be appointed by the Organizing Committee. No objection shall be entertained on such appointments.

**Protest:**

19. A protest fee of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) must be remitted along with any protest that may be lodge by a team. "No" objection or protest shall be withdrawn except with permission of the Organizing Committee. All protests in regard to a game must be lodged within half an hour of the completion of the match in respect of which the protest is lodged. However, 'NO' protest on the referee's decision or on points of facts, shall be entertained.
